

How to use the video player on DW.COM

Start a video



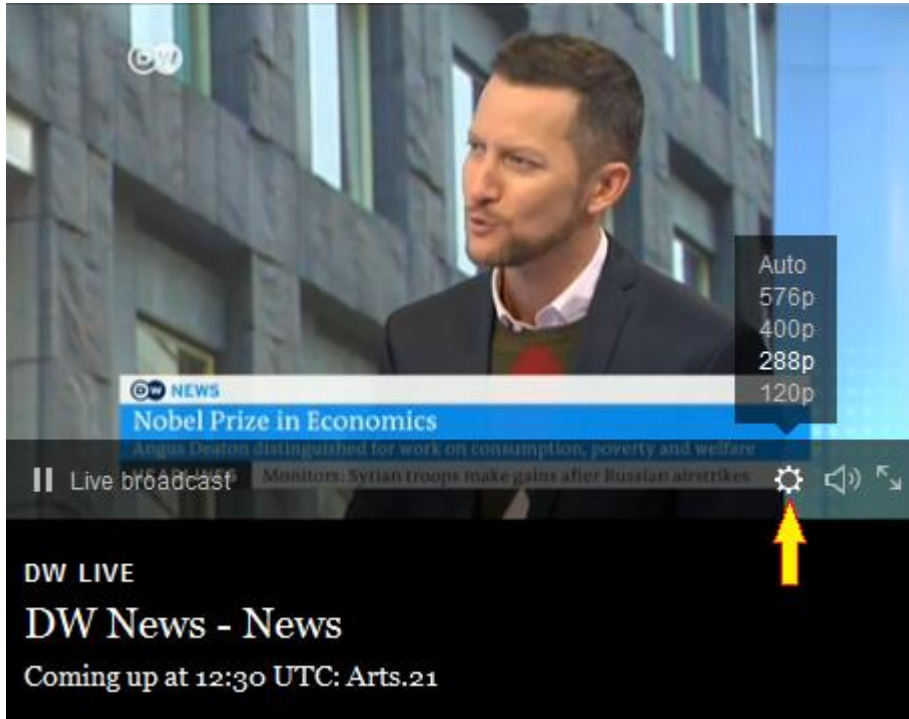
1. Click on the play button (the video will begin to play).

Pause a video



1. Move the mouse arrow over the video (the control panel will appear under the video screen).
2. Click on the pause symbol.

Change the quality settings



1. Move the mouse arrow to the bottom right corner of the display (the control panel will appear under the video screen).
2. Move the mouse arrow over the cogwheel symbol (a list with the quality settings will appear).
3. Click on:
 1. "Auto" to choose the best possible video quality for your internet connection.
 2. One of the different quality levels (a resolution setting is shown, larger values mean better quality).

Change the volume



1. Move the mouse arrow over the video (the control panel appears under the video screen).
2. Move the mouse arrow over the speaker symbol (a vertical volume meter will appear).
 1. Click on the volume bar to change the volume **or** –
 2. Use the "arrow up" / "arrow down" key on your keyboard to change the volume.

Show videos in full screen



1. Move the mouse arrow over the video (the control panel will appear under the video screen).
2. Click on the full screen symbol (full screen mode will activate automatically).
3. Click again on the full screen symbol (or press the esc key) to deactivate full screen mode.

Display subtitles

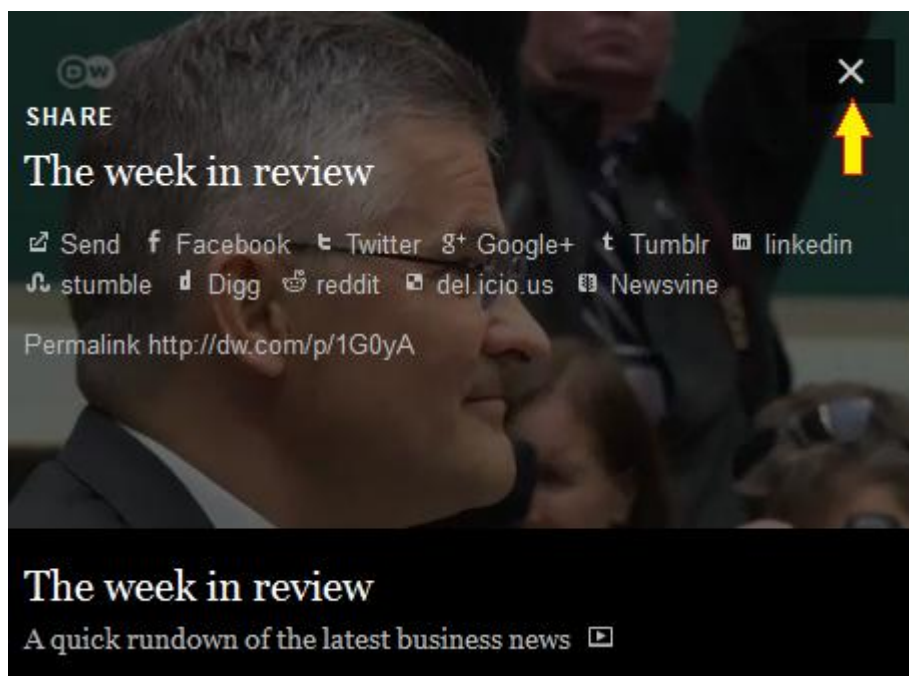
This function is only available with certain videos.



1. Move the mouse arrow over the video (the control panel will appear under the video screen).
2. Click on the "Closed Caption" symbol, to display and deactivate subtitles.

Sharing videos on social networks

This function is only available with certain videos.



1. Move the mouse arrow over the video (the control panel will appear under the video screen).

2. Click on the "share" button (the video stops and different social networks will be displayed).
3. Click on a listed network and share the video.
4. Click on the close symbol (the video will continue playing).
