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SUMMARY OF GRAMMAR

Note the following:

- bin** = the first person singular of the verb **sein** (to be)
ich = the personal pronoun in the first person singular

when introducing people

In this lesson you find out that the language course takes place in a hotel, the Hotel Europa. And you are introduced to the main characters in the story:

Frau Berger:

She is the hotel manageress and she likes singing.

Andreas Schäfer:

He is the hotel porter.

Dr. Thürmann:

He is a regular guest at the Hotel Europa.

He is hard of hearing.

Hanna Clasen:

She is the chambermaid.

Ex:

She is a little elf. Although she is invisible, her voice can be heard clearly. She also understands and speaks German. You will find out more about her (and the origin of her name) in Lesson 8.

This is how the main characters are introduced:

Sprecher: Das ist Herr Schäfer. Andreas Schäfer.
Das ist Herr Dr. Thürmann.
Das ist Frau Berger. Lisa Berger.
Das ist Hanna. Hanna Clasen.

Ex introduces herself . . .

Ex: Hallo! Hallo! Da bin ich.

Ex repeats the names of the main characters:

Ex: Ich – und Andreas und Frau Berger und Hanna und Dr. Thürmann.

Andreas is at the reception desk of the Hotel Europa. He answers the telephone.

Andreas: Rezeption. Guten Abend. Hotel Europa, Rezeption.
