The Crash

New York based Lehman Brothers filed for bankruptcy on 15 September 2008. It was the end of more than 150 proud years in business. At the time, the investment bank was more than 600 billion US dollars in debt. The collapse didn't just affect the US financial world; Lehman's global reach meant companies all over the world went down with the sinking ship. In Singapore alone, more than 500 investors suddenly faced imminent ruin. Savings were wiped out overnight. The Lehman Brothers' collapse plunged the world into financial and economic crisis. How could this have happened? And above all: could it happen again? Ten years after the bankruptcy, the documentary **The Crash – The Investment Bank Lehman Brothers** charts the risky rise and ruinous fall of a global financial services giant.

Life After the Crash

The impact of the Lehman collapse was simply devastating – both for individuals and entire economies. The business magazine **Made in Germany** has been talking to a former Lehman banker in New York; fired, he left the bank with nothing but a cardboard box. Now he gives DW an exclusive account of the events of 15 September 2008. Iceland also found itself on the edge of the abyss when its domestic banking sector collapsed, plunging 80 percent of Icelandic companies into insolvency. The island nation was all but officially bankrupt, dragged into the 2008 financial maelstrom. But today, the Icelandic economy has recovered to pre-crash levels. Sex and Love 3.0

The digital revolution has massively transformed our lives – including how we experience sex and love. The new technology promises one thing above all else: self-realization. Entire industries are working on ways to fan desire, find partners and improve relationships. How successful are these efforts? Will we soon be living in some sort of sexual nirvana? In the documentary **Sex and Love 3.0**, Alice and Christoff, both in their early 30s, test some of the current trends. How will we experience eroticism in the future? The market for pornography, sex toys, potency drugs and erotic literature is booming. Virtual Reality (VR) promises new sexual experiences. Hi-tech simulators enable virtual sex via the Internet. Young people today are growing up with very different erotic experiences. At the same time, it's getting more difficult to find a steady partner, to have a relationship, or to start a family. Most Germans may still believe in true love, but the average relationship lasts less than three years. Will sex robots make better partners in the future?

Vintage Car Beach Rally

During the first weekend of September, the Danish holiday island of Rømø becomes a hotspot for the vintage car scene. For a couple of days, the sound of waves breaking on idyllic beaches is replaced by the roar of engines. At the "Rømø Motor Festival," the white sandy beach is turned into a race track for cars and motorbikes built before 1947. The track is a classic 1/8 mile (ca. 201 m) drag strip - a place where these vintage vehicles can show what they're (still) made of. Drivers can race as often as they like. The fastest vehicle wins. This year, more than 100 participants from 11 nations are expected to attend, as well as at least 10,000 people to cheer them on. Many turn the excursion into a trip back in time, dressing in pre-war fashions. **Euromaxx** presents the highlights of the festival.
